Lesson Objectives:

Summary of Tasks / Actions:

- Write and sign your own pledge to recycle more
- Or- take and sign one of the example pledge copies
- An example of a pledge may be: "Reduce my waste by using reusable water bottles, coffee mugs, and food containers. Recycle paper, plastic, and metal in designated recycling bins. Use energy-efficient appliances. Turn off lights and electronics when not in use." and then a place for them to sign their name.
- Reflective question- ask them what made you want to make this commitment or how will you follow through on your commitment? How will you share this with others?
